NEWS RELEASE

May 5, 2026

On 27 April 2026 police responded to the 11000 block of Southwest Highway in reference to an Aggravated Assault. The complainant explained that he told a patron that he couldn't park in handicap parking without a placard. The unknown subject then left the business, went to his vehicle, retrieved a large knife, and reentered the business. Once 911 was called, the armed subject fled the scene.

On 28 April 2026 police arrested Courtland T. Claude, age 25 of Palos Hills, on an active Cook County Warrant. The arrest stemmed from an incident that occurred in the 10300 block of Roberts Road.

On 28 April 2026 police responded to the 7900 block of 100th Place in reference to a Deceptive Practices. The complainant received a bill for the recent purchase of a new phone and service from AT&T. However, the complainant utilizes T-Mobile and never opened an account with AT&T. The incident is under investigation.

On 28 April 2026 police arrested Erika V. Saavedra-Fernandez, age 32 of Lansing, for Driving with Revoked Registration and other traffic offenses. The arrest stemmed from a traffic stop in the 8400 block of 111th Street.

However, the complainant utilizes a different carrier and never opened an account with Verizon. The incident is under investigation.

On 1 May 2026 police responded to the 8500 block of 103rd Terrace in reference to a Burglary from Motor Vehicle. The complainant explained that they park their truck in the community parking lot. On 1 May 2026 when they returned to their truck the bed cover was removed and various items of scrap metal, worth approximately \$550.00, were taken. The incident is under investigation.
