On 16 June 2026 police arrested Brandon D. Campbell, age 35 of Des Plaines, for Driving While Driver's License Suspended and other traffic offenses. The arrest stemmed from a traffic crash which occurred at the intersection of Sheffield and Paxos Drives.

On 17 June 2026 police responded to Stella's Gaming Café, located at 7634 111th Street, in reference to a delayed Burglary. Upon arrival, officers observed the front glass door shattered and 4 gaming machines were damaged inside. The cash boxes to the machines were taken. The total loss is unknown at this time. The incident is under investigation.

On 17 June 2026 police responded to the 8400 block of 101st Terrace in reference to a Battery. The complainant explained that they were struck in the face by their friend. The incident is under investigation.

On 18 June 2026 police responded to the 10000 block of Roberts Road in reference to an Arson. Upon arrival, officers observed 2 vehicles engulfed in flames. The fires were extinguished by North Palos Fire Protection District. The incident is under investigation.

On 18 June 2026 police responded to the police department for a Deceptive Practices complaint. The complainant explained that they received an Apple Pay Support fraud alert. They followed the prompts and believed they were speaking to a representative of their bank. The representative told the complainant that they needed to move their money out of the bank. The complainant was advised to withdraw \$25,000.00, put it into a shoebox, and then give it to a subject that would arrive at their home. A few days later, the complainant was contacted again and was convinced to wire another \$12,500.00. After the complainant sent the money, they

realized they had been scammed. The incident is under investigation.

On 18 June 2026 police responded to the 11200 block of Southwest Highway in reference to a Theft. The complainant explained that a female subject entered the establishment and inquired about some golf clubs. When the associate left to get the golf clubs, the female subject took 3 putters valued at approximately \$1500.00 and left the store. The female subject then entered a vehicle and fled southbound on Southwest Highway.

On 18 June 2026 police responded to the 10800 block of 84th Avenue in reference to a Theft. The complainant explained that they locked their Schwinn GTX3 Hybrid bike in the storage area of their complex. When they returned to the storage area, their bike was missing. The incident is under investigation.

On 20 June 2026 police responded to Tacos Juniors located at 9736 Roberts Road for a Burglary. After throwing a landscaping brick through the front glass door, two masked and gloved subjects entered the establishment. They proceeded to take the safe and exit through the rear of the building. The incident is under investigation.

On 20 June 2026 police arrested Mateusz S. Zych, age 22 of Palos Hills, for Driving Under the Influence and other traffic offenses. The arrest stemmed from a traffic stop, due to a vehicle that drove through a caution tape perimeter marking a traffic crash scene.

Always lock your vehicle, even when it's parked in your driveway or garage. Always take your key fob and garage door opener with you.
