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NEWS RELEASE

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On 2 August 2026 police responded to the 10100 block of Roberts Road for a Theft. The complainant explained that a subject ate and drank at their establishment. When presented with the check, the subject fled through the patio, entered a waiting vehicle, and drove away. The incident is under investigation.

On 3 August 2026 police responded to the 10400 block of Winter Park Drive in reference to a Burglary from Motor Vehicle. The complainant explained that they parked their vehicle and left the doors unlocked. In the early morning hours, a subject entered their vehicle and took a 9mm Glock 43 handgun that was in the center console. The incident is under investigation.

On 7 August 2026 police arrested Anthony L. Ladd, age 40 of Chicago, for Driving Under the Influence and other traffic offenses. The arrest stemmed from a traffic stop in the 8900 block of 95th Street.

On 7 August 2026 police responded to the 8900 block of 101st Place in reference to a Deceptive Practices. The complainant explained that they received a text message from their iCloud account that their account was compromised. They were given a phone number to call. The complainant called and was advised to buy \$1200.00 in gift cards and then to provide the pin numbers to the caller. After sending the money, the complainant realized it was a scam. The incident is under investigation.

On 8 August 2026 police responded to Darla's Gaming Café located at 10602 S. Roberts Road in reference to a Burglary. When police arrived, they observed the front door's glass was shattered. Inside, they observed 3 gaming machines which were damaged. The amount of money taken is unknown at this time. The incident is under investigation.

To keep yourself safe from a vishing attack, the most important thing to remember is you should never provide or confirm personal information over the phone. Remember that credit card companies, banks, and government officials will never call asking for sensitive information.

Always lock your vehicle, even when it's parked in your driveway or garage. Always take your key fob and garage door opener with you.
